Greater Depth Order the times from latest to earliest where compared times are to the half hour and hour; some hour digits missing from clocks.

Developing Complete the sentences using earlier and later to describe the times shown where compared times are given to the hour only; all hour digits given on clocks.

Expected Complete the sentences using earlier and later to describe the times shown, where compared times are given to the half hour or hour; all hour digits given on clocks.

Greater Depth Complete the sentences using the given words. Clocks given to the half hour or hour; some hour digits missing from clocks.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Reasoning and Problem Solving)

Developing Use the clues to find three possible solutions using times given in seconds and the terms 'faster' and 'slower'.

Expected Use the clues to find four possible solutions using times given in seconds, ordinal numbers and the terms 'faster' and 'slower'.

Greater Depth Use the clues to suggest durations of time using times in seconds, ordinal numbers and the terms 'faster' and 'slower'.

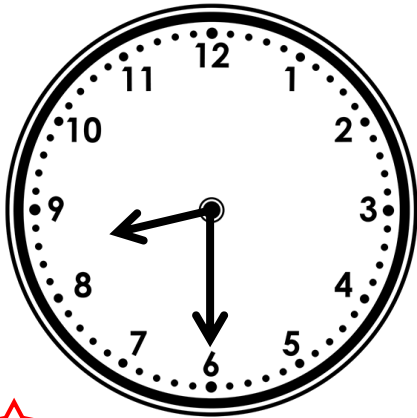
